

2023/2024 Protected Disclosure Annual Report
University of Winnipeg

The University of Winnipeg is designated as a "government body" under *The Public Interest Disclosure (Whistleblower Protection) Act* (PIDA). All government bodies are required to implement procedures to manage disclosures of wrongdoing, as defined by PIDA.

The University of Winnipeg's Protected Disclosure Policy and procedures were created to comply with PIDA. The policy and procedures establish processes to facilitate the disclosure and investigation of significant and serious matters relating to the University that are potentially unlawful, dangerous to any person, or injurious to the interests of the University. The policy protects persons who make such disclosures in good faith from reprisals.

The Act requires that an annual report be prepared with the number of disclosures received, the number acted on and not acted on, the number of investigations initiated as a result of a disclosure, and the outcomes of the investigation.
